Empire State College Graduation Requirements

Twenty-four semester/credit hours must be taken at Empire State College, 32 credits must be in liberal studies, and up to 40 can be transferred from other sources (college transfer, military credit, national testing). Students will work with an Empire State College academic mentor to determine liberal studies/concentration courses and develop their degree plan. Required concentration areas/courses will vary depending on the student's focus.

Credit by Evaluation

Credit by evaluation (CBE) allows students to gain college credit for learning acquired through life and work experience including learning gained outside the classroom. Because it cannot be determined prior to enrollment, credit by evaluation is not included in this template. Once enrolled, students can speak to their advisor about taking advantage of this process.
